General Class Expectations

- Quizzes are given throughout many of the units as a checkpoint for understanding. Quizzes are never pop-quizzes. Math 7 students may retake quizzes. There are no retakes in Pre-Algebra.
- Tests will be given at the end of each unit to assess mastery. Time allowance for make-up tests (when you are absent the day of the test) is <u>one week</u>. There are no retakes for chapter tests.

Grading

• A grade will be given each quarter (9-week period) based on knowledge and thinking (tests, quizzes, daily assignments), participation, oral communication, written communication (show your work), collaboration, and agency. A semester grade is also given which is an average of two quarters.
